GENERAL OBJECTIVES: knowledge of etiology, diagnosis, prevention, conservative and surgical management of diseases of the oral cavity and soft tissues.

## Objectives of lectures (5 lectures)

**1. Defense mechanisms in the oral cavity. Methodical examinations of the mucose of oral cavity (clinical and additional). Cytology and biopsy procedures in the oral pathology - indications and procedures. Formulating the preliminary and definitive diagnosis. Characteristics of oral mucose lesions.**

**2. White, red and red-white lesions on the oral mucosa, pigmented lesions. Pathological lesions and on the floor of the mouth, on the buccal mucosa and buccal sulci.**

**3. Pathological lesions on the lips and on the tongue. Pathological lesions on the gingival, mucosa of edentulous jaw and palate.**

**4. Allergy lesions in the oral cavity. Diseases of salivary gland and related clinical manifestations in the oral cavity. Precancer oral diseases and oral cancer - clinical and histopathological pictures.**

**5. Principles of proceedings the general practitioner. Pharmacological and surgical treatment of oral pathology.**
