## Practical classes

- 1.Traffic accidents statistics, victims count, social and financial cost of traffic accidents in Poland and in the whole world. Activities demanded from physicians in case of traffic accidents by law enforcement institutions and courts.
- 2.Medical examination of traffic accidents victims. Toxicological examination of traffic accidents victims the rules of physician's participation, physician's duties and rights. Special demands from medical files when the patient suffered from traffic accident.
- 3. Rules of communication between physicians and law enforcement institutions. Rules of determining lesions severity degree along the rules established by penal codes and for the purposes of civil compensation.
- 4. Qualifying traffic accident victims' cadavers to undergo autopsy. Autopsy rules and special procedures in cases of traffic accident victims. Rules of determining the cause of death on the basis of autopsy findings in traffic accidents' victims.
- 5.Multi-disciplinary traffic accident reconstruction by experts' teams. Possibilities and limitations of determining scenario and results of traffic accidents, distinguishing between driver and passengers of various road vehicles.
