C1. Learning about effective ways to promote oral health

C2. Learning the principles of effective education in relation to the most important multifactorial diseases of the oral cavity: caries, periodontopathy and cancer of the oral mucosa.

Seminars

1. Introduction to the promotion of oral health - the basics of classes and concepts. Description of the assumptions of the Ottawa Charter, contemporary health promotion according to WHO assumptions. Polish legal system in the field of oral health promotion.
2. Principles of constructing actions promoting oral health and prophylactic programs in dentistry. Examples of targeted dental prophylaxis programs according to WHO.
3. Outline of the epidemiology of the most important dental diseases of civilization in the field of dentistry: oral cavity cancer, caries, periodontitis.
4. Preparation of an action promoting oral health and a program promoting oral health. Assessment of the implementation of such programs.
 1. Organization of the oral cavity prophylaxis day. Preparation of a targeted prevention program for selected oral pathology in adults and / or children.
