- 1. Familiarising with the structure of the hospital and the ward.
- 2. Administrative activities related to the treatment of patients (admissions, discharge, transfers).
- 3. Ward supplies (food, medicines, equipment).
- 4. Help in feeding the patients.
- 5. Sanitary and hygienic services for the patients (making beds, toilets).
- 6. Measuring heart rate, temperature, blood pressure.
- 7. Help with administering drugs.

- 8. Assistance in the preparation of instruments, syringes sterilization technique, the concept of sepsis and antisepsis.
- 9. Learning and performing subcutaneous and intramuscular injections.
- 10. Help with medical procedures.
- 11. Taking patients to their examination appointments.
- 12. Participating in ward rounds.
