5. Sanitary and hygienic services for the patients (making beds, toilets).
6. Measuring heart rate, temperature, blood pressure.
7. Help with administering drugs.

8. Assistance in the preparation of instruments, syringes - sterilization technique, the concept of sepsis and antisepsis.
9. Learning and performing subcutaneous and intramuscular injections.
10. Help with medical procedures.
11. Taking patients to their examination appointments.
12. Participating in ward rounds.
13. Participation and assistance in consultation of patient tests.
