Content of classes:

**Summer practice:**

1. In the field of administrative work, student familiarises with:

- sanitary and epidemiological regulations and regulations regarding work safety at the dental clinic
- registration of patients at the dental clinic and filling in the medical history cards
- writing referrals for laboratory and consultation tests, etc.
- keeping monthly reports on the work of the clinic as well as reports on the supplies of the clinic such as

medicines, materials, instruments and work clothes

2. In the field of dental assistance:

- getting acquainted with various methods of sterilization of instruments: water, steam and room sterilization.
- daily maintenance and sterilization of: handpieces, small instruments, foot control, reflector, suction and dental chair.

3. Preparation of the office for the patients.

4. Preparation of the patient for the dental procedure.

5. Passive and active assistance during treatments - four-handed work.

6. Planning and carrying out treatments in the field of carious, periodontal and orthodontic prophylaxis.

7. Cleaning the office after treatment of the patients.

8. Providing information to patients on their behaviour in relation to oral hygiene and dental prophylaxis.

9. Applying the principles of ergonomic organization of work at the dental clinic.

10. Keeping medical records.
